## Multitudes, multitudes in the valley of decision: for the day of the LORD *is* near in the valley of decision. (Joel 3:14)

The decision -- how can we best prepare for "**the day of the Lord?**" In this regard, Malachi asks the key question: "But who may abide the day of his coming? and who shall stand when he appeareth?" (Malachi 3:2) In the midst of the increasing decadence in the world, many are greatly concerned. But we know that we can trust in the Lord. The scriptures are clear. Are we willing to hear? We may not know what the future holds, but we do know who holds the future, and to be in step with Him is the greatest opportunity of our existence.
